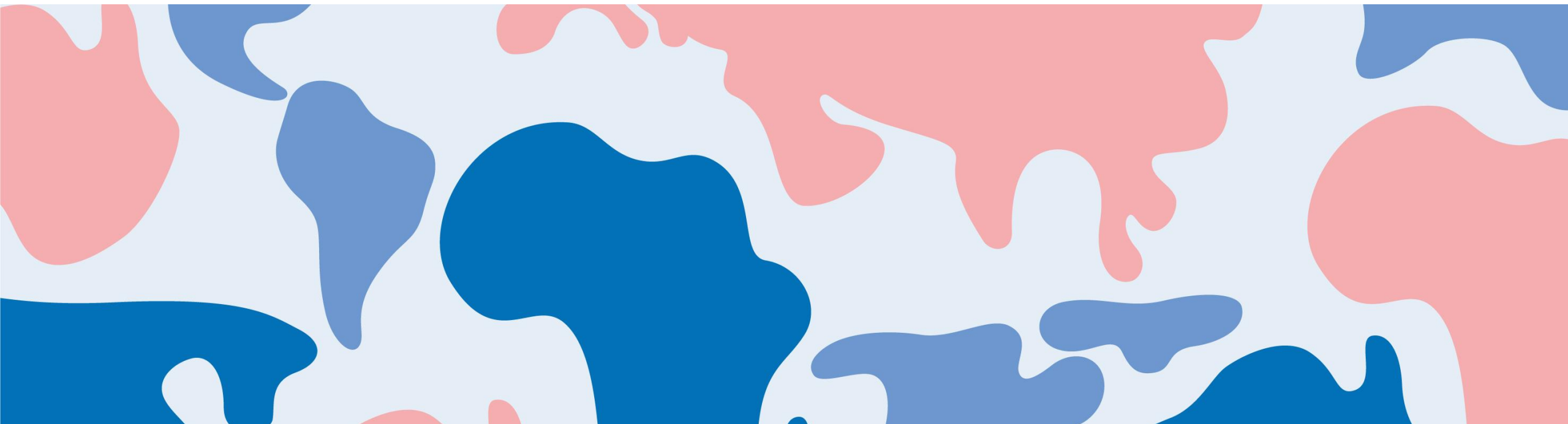

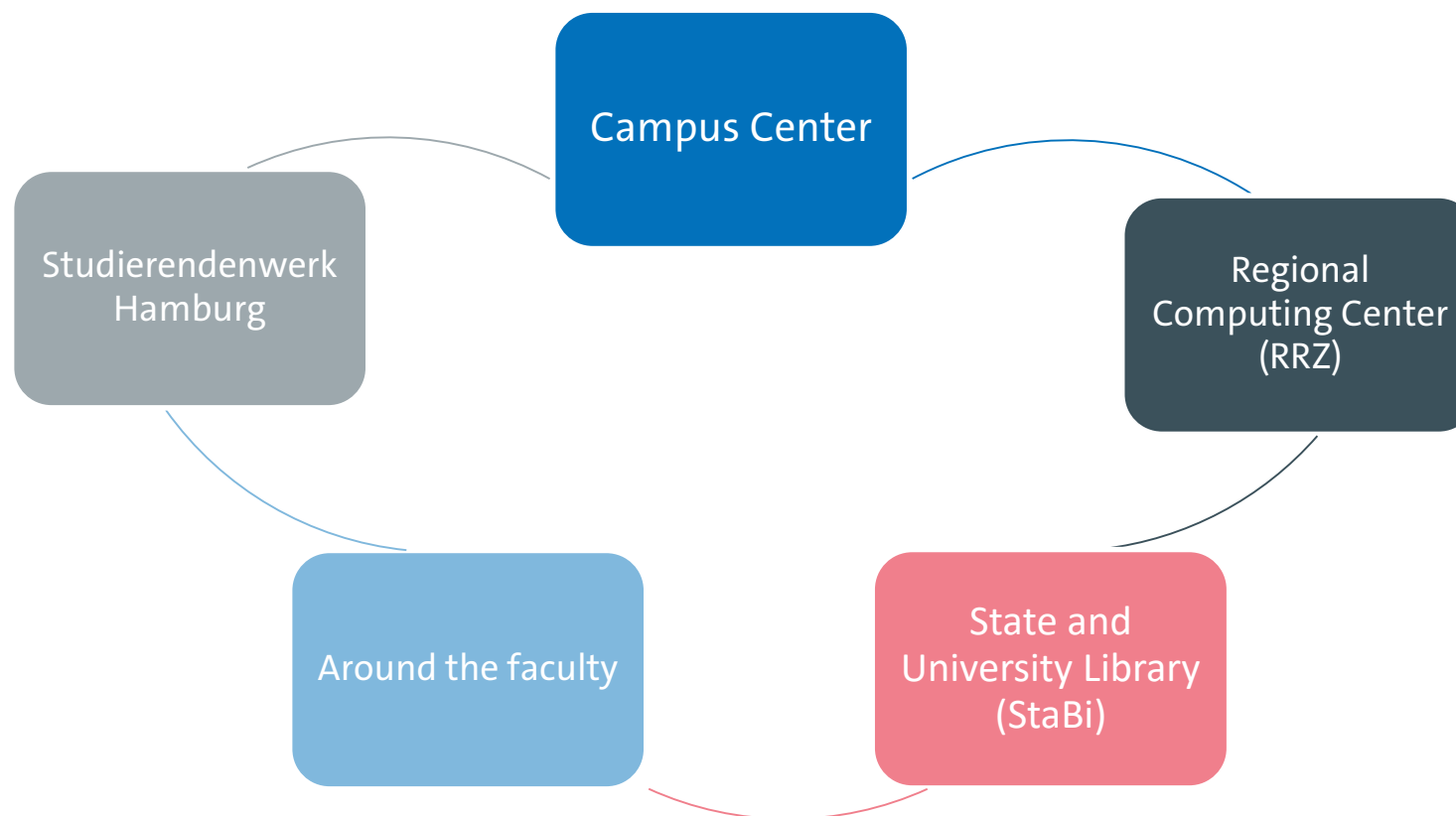

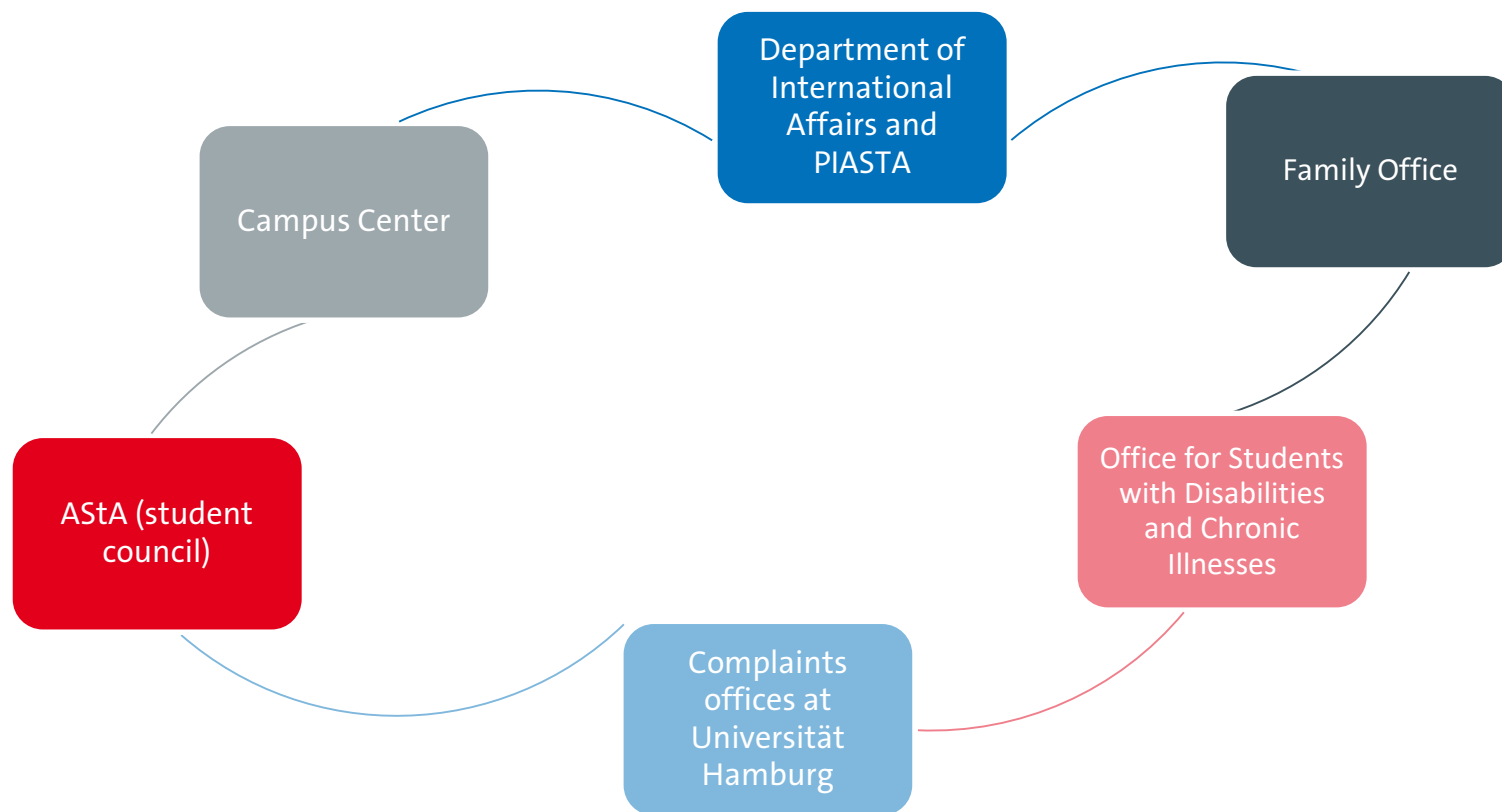

Campus Center

Center for Academic Advising

- Services for prospective students, including refugees
- Advice on all questions related to your studies (e.g., performance pressure, stress, exam anxiety, and time management)
- Advice on dealing with doubts regarding studies (continue, change, or drop out?)

Psychological counseling

- For worries and needs (e.g., self-doubt, learning difficulties, and fears)
- Advice on sexual harassment, discrimination, and violence
- Support for students with mental illness (HOPES)

Department of International Affairs and PIASTA

For international students:

- **International student support:** advice on residential, social, and personal matters
- **Björn Stehn (attorney):** legal advice
- **Dominik Meckel :** advice on scholarships

For all students:

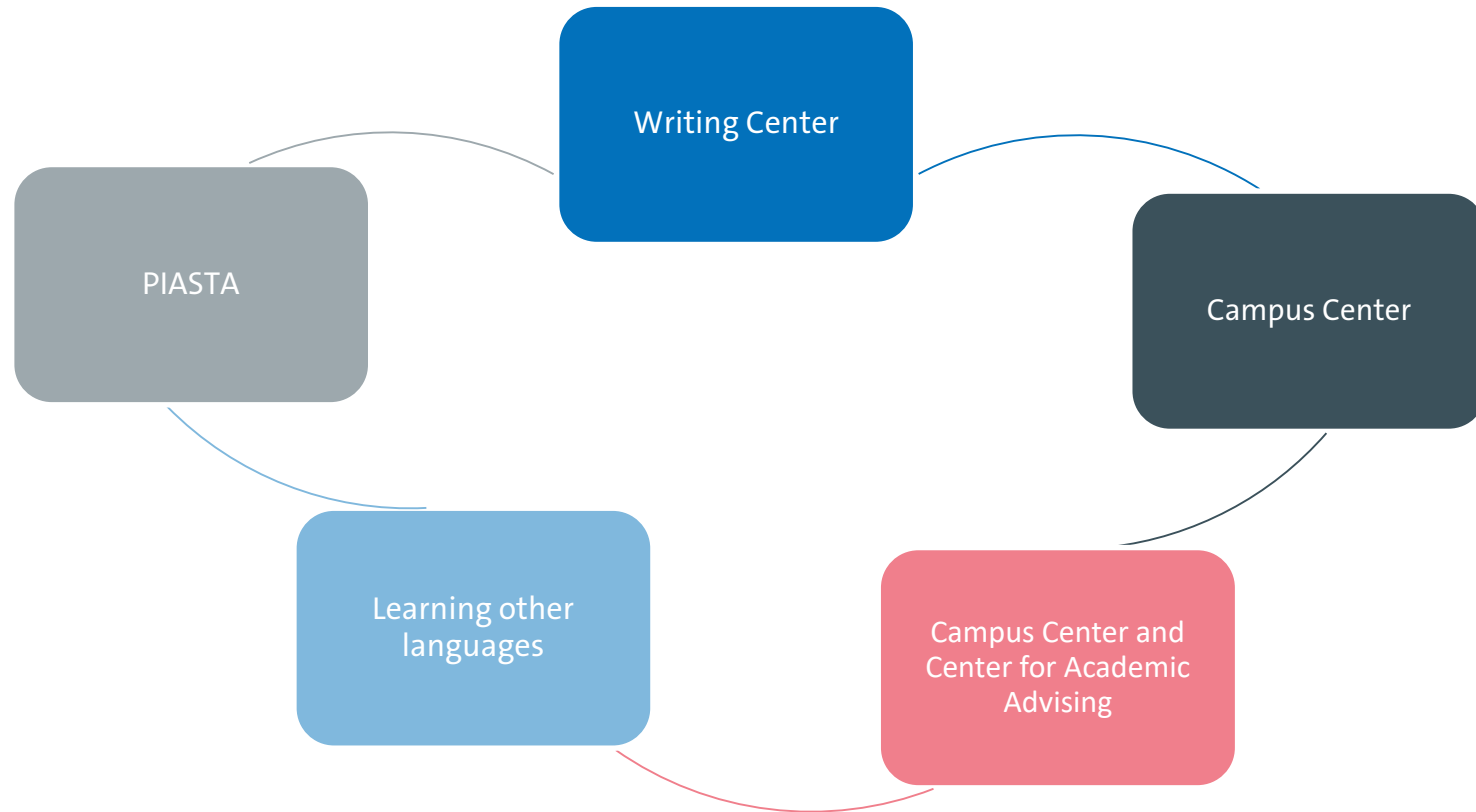

Free ticket for new students

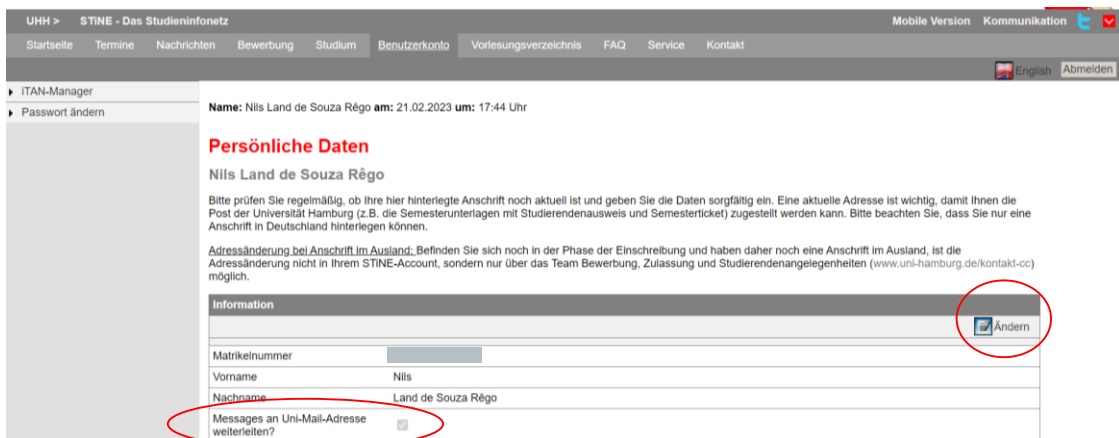
- For all students in the first and second semester

- Linking to Surfmail: STiNE portal → Account → Forward messages to uni-mail-account → Change

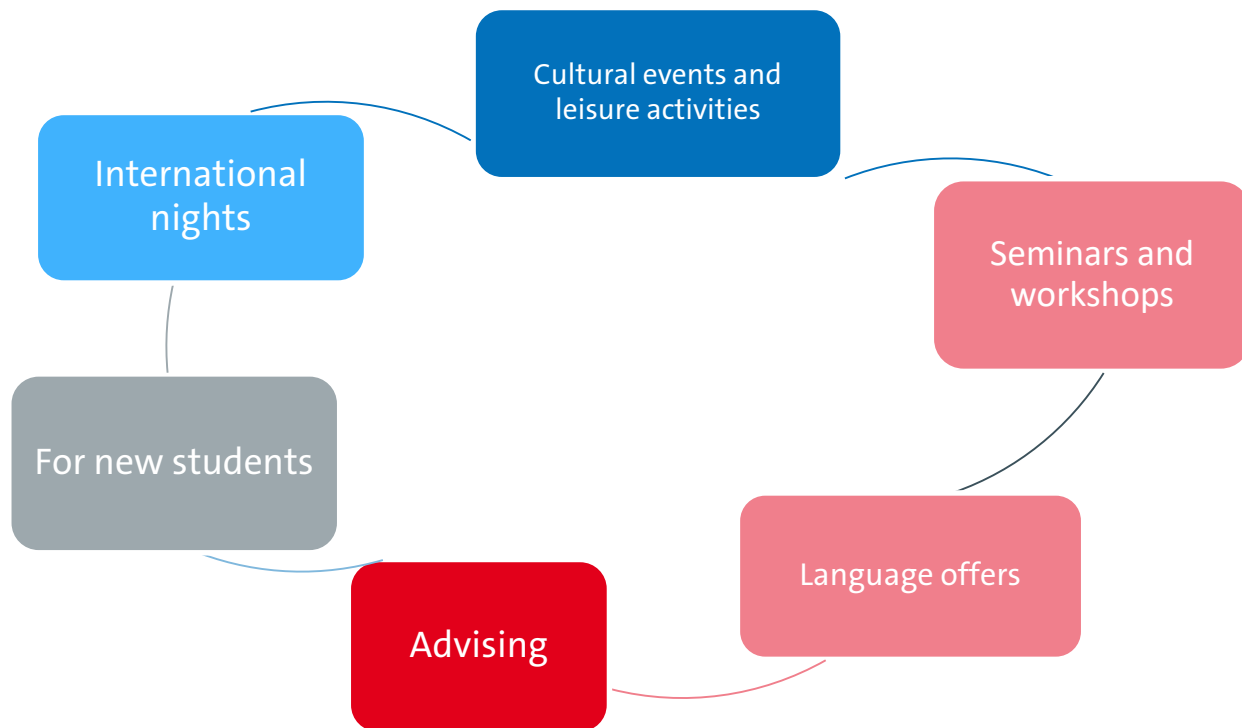


Surfmail (@studium.uni-hamburg.de)

- **Important!** When communicating with teaching staff, academic advisors, classmates, and any other university staff, **you should always send mails using your uni-hamburg.de email address.**

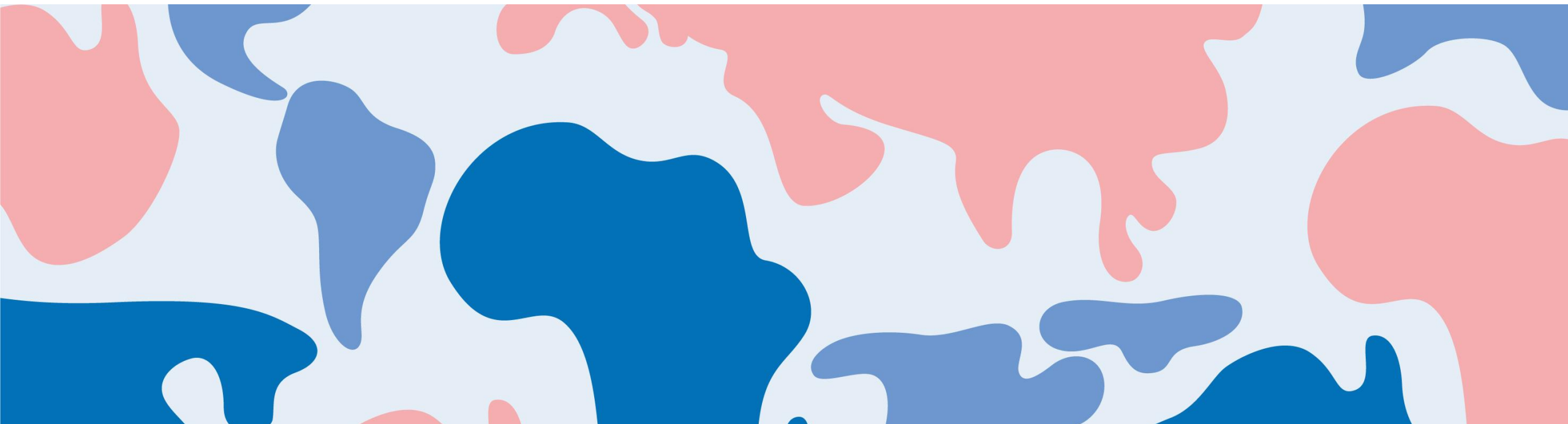
